

The discovery has made Mansar one of the prime archaeological sites in the country. The excavation started in 1997 by Bodhisatva Nagarjun Smarak Sanstha Va Anusandhan Kendra (a local Buddhist research institute) and carried forward

by ASI which, now, is working towards restoring, protecting, preserving and making the site as tourist attraction.






Celebration of Constitution Day 26th Nov 2015
