# "Guest Lecture on Prevention of Sexual Harassment at Work Place" 25th November 2022

More than half of the working professionals in India admitted to being subjected to inappropriate touching or other physical advances at workplaces, revealed a recent survey by Women's Indian Chamber of Commerce and Industry's (WICCI) Council of Ethics. Keeping this in mind, Green Heaven Institute of Management and Research, Nagpur(GHIMR), organized a "Workshop on Prevention of Sexual Harassment at Work Place" on 25th November 2022. The Session was conducted by Adv. Preeti Bhange, Law Officer, Social Welfare Department Nagpur. In her address to the students and staff of GHIMR, Adv Bhange explained, that sexual harassment at workplace does not only cause mental and/or physical damage to the person harassed; but also seriously curtails opportunities at work by creating a discriminatory work environment. The session covered aspects related to hearing and addressing complaints regarding sexual harassment and spreading awareness about gender-related issues and functioning of the Internal Complaints Committee. She stressed upon how a person's body language plays an important role in understanding what he or she feels. Discussing about various forms of sexual harassment (verbal, physical, visual), Adv Bhange said that silence doesn't always mean that any act is welcome; and encouraging some behaviour doesn't mean that any kind of behaviour is welcome. She also discussed how many women do not complain or report due to fear of retaliation, social stigma, lack of evidence, fear of loss of reputation, low selfconfidence, fear of job loss or lack of awareness. Explaining the importance of Internal Committee in every organization, Ms. Bhange talked about Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace Act, 2013 and discussed the timelines and Pit Stops for Internal Complaint Committee and how the Committee works. The workshop was coordinated by Dr. Rajani Kumar assisted by Mr. Robin Ukey under the guidance of Dr. Anil Sharma, Director GHIMR.









# Report on Learn Earn and Grow- A Business Opportunity Program 22.01.2023

With an objective of providing the students a thorough understanding of the stock market and give them a practical exposure to online trading, a session in collaboration with **DigiBiz Global Education Pvt Ltd** was conducted for the students. **Mr.Mohd Shahid, Founder and CEO,** explained that stock market refers to several exchanges in which shares of publicly held companies are bought and sold. Stock markets are venues where buyers and sellers meet to exchange equity shares of public corporations. #### A SEMINAR ON SELF EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AND GOVERNMENT'S SELF EMPLOYMENT SCHEMES AND SUBSIDIES

Date: 9th June 2023

Green Heaven Institute of Management and Research, Nagpur supported by Maharashtra Centre for Entrepreneurship Development (MCED), Green Heaven Collage recently organized a Seminar on Self Employment Opportunities and Government's Self Employment Schemes and Subsidies. The key speaker for the webinar was Dr.Swati Wasnik,, Regional Coordinator, MCED, Civil Lines & Mr.Bhushan Sahasrabudhe Carrier Guidance MCED Nagpur. The college has all ready signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with MCED for furthering the cause of entrepreneurship among management students. The primary objective of the Seminar was to develop entrepreneurship spirit among the management students and to apprise them about the various self-employment opportunities available in today's era.

Dr.Swati wasnik & Mr.Bhushan Sahasrabudhe elaborated in detail on the Chief Ministers' Employment Generation Program (PMEGP). The scheme is available to any individual in the age group 18 to 45yrs. Upper age relaxation of 5 years is offered to persons belonging to SC/ST community, women, ex-servicemen and differently able persons. The educational qualification under the program is 7<sup>th</sup> pass for project cost ranging between Rs. 10 lacs to Rs. 25 lacs. The same is 10<sup>th</sup> pass for project cost ranging between Rs. 25 lacs to Rs. 50 lacs. The maximum loan limit for manufacturing project has been set at Rs. 50 lacs while for service project the same is Rs. 10 lacs. Under the PMEGP, the owner's equity is capped at 10% of the project cost.

Dr.Swati wasnik & Mr.Bhushan Sahasrabudhe spoke at length and explained in detail about how to set up micro, small and medium enterprises (MCED) and state government's schemes and subsidies and the related training support provided by MCED.







Prof. Robin Ukey welcomed the guest speaker and Dr. Mubina Saifee proposed a vote of thanks. Dr. Anil Sharma, Director and Dr.Rajani Kumar, Academic Coordinator appreciated the staff efforts for organizing the event.

Date: 18 March 2023



This was followed by the first round of interviews by the companies. 78 students appeared for the first round of the interview, out of which, 54 got shortlisted. #### **Report of NISM Training**

#### 15th November to 3rd December 2021

To enhance the employability skills of students for the betterment of the placements of the Institute, Green Heaven Institute of Management and Research, Nagpur has come in collaboration with Ramai Infotech, a training Institute for NISM Certificate Courses, an orientation session was organized on 25<sup>th</sup> October 21 based on this. The National Institute of Securities Markets (NISM) was set up by the Stock Exchange Board of India(SEBI) in 2006 to provide education about the securities market in India. This orientation session was conducted by 'Ramai Suresh Foundation', in association with Ramai Infotech and its partner ICICI Foundation through its CSR initiative offers student employable skill training programs. The orientation session was attended by 125+ students of Sem -3 and pass out students (of batch 2018-20). During the orientation session the speaker of the session Mrs. Seema Manojia, Operations Manageer, Ramai Infotech, explained the learning outcomes of the training program and urged the students that certification will help them to become a certified professional to persue career in Mutual Fund Industry. The training session was proposed to start on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2021.

Under the online training program students were imparted complimentary 40 hrs, 15 days training to qualify the influential NISM-Series-V-A: Mutual Fund Distributors Certification Examination. The Modules were covered in 15 sessions. After 10 sessions a Mock test on NISM portal was conducted, students who qualified were only allowed to book exam slot. Rest 5 days training is imparted to students who could not qualify for booking the exam slot. Then again these students to reappear in the Mock test. There were students in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Mock who could not score the benchmark of 60%, therefore eliminated from the Program. A total of 43 students registered for this training program.

There were 5 students in total who could qualify to register for the exam. Out of these 5 students, 2 students could actually get the NISM certificate. The names of these students were Priya Jaiswal and Ruby Sayyad.

The training program was free and the examination fee cost was borne by the Institute.
