


## Green Heaven Institute of Management and Research offer tribute to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on his death anniversary

The government of India declared his birthday October 30<sup>th</sup> as Rashtriya Ekta Diwas (National Unity Day).

It was due to Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's protest in Gujrat, against increased taxes for famine and flood-hit farmers in 1928 that he was conferred with the title of 'Sardar.' In 1942, despite struggling with poor health, Patel played a prominent role in galvanising the public in the Quit India Movement. Patel served as Independent India's first home minister. He is called a self-made man in the truest sense of the word. His integration and ideologies laid the groundwork for unity. He received the Bharat Ratna Award in 1991. Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel died on December 15, 1950.

Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel will always be remembered for his monumental service, his administrative skills and the untiring efforts to unite our nation. He was an abundant source of inspiration for the nation's youth, not only in the Freedom movement but also today.
